To the Student and Parents:

We understand that a provisional license shall not authorize its holder to operate a motor vehicle with more than one passenger who is less than 18 years old for the first year after the license is issued. For drivers less than 18 years of age, but after the one year restricted period, we understand that a provisional license shall not authorize its holder to operate a motor vehicle with more than three passengers who are less than 18 years old. (Section 46.2-334.01 of the Code of Virginia)

We realize that driving to school and parking on campus is a privilege. We also realize that the student must obey the regulations printed on this application and in the student handbook. The student will not drive on a revoked permit, nor will we hold Mountain View High School or its agents liable for any damages or theft pertaining to this vehicle while on school grounds.

We further certify that the information on both sides of this card is correct and that we understand the conditions of this student driving to school.

We understand that any vehicle parked on school grounds is subject to search.

Student Regulations for Driving to School

1. Student vehicles must be registered and display a parking permit.
2. Parking permits are to be hung from the vehicle's rearview mirror and may not be transferred from the registered vehicle to another vehicle without notifying Administration.
3. Students are to drive directly to the Student Parking Lot and park. Do not "cruise" around or leave school grounds until the end of the school day.
4. Any student who drives a vehicle on school grounds in a reckless manner will be subject to criminal action by the County Sheriff's Department. Driving in excess of 15MPH, fast starts, and skidding of tires are examples of reckless driving.
5. School campus traffic offenses including, but not limited to, unsafe operation of a vehicle; and/or failure to obey those rules necessary to obtain a school parking sticker will result in a minimum of a warning to a maximum of long-term suspension of 11-180 days with the balance of any days to be served carrying over to the succeeding school year.
6. Vehicles are to be parked within the applicable painted lines: students parked across lines or diagonally or in any way which takes more than one parking space will be subject to disciplinary action.
7. Sitting in vehicles or loitering in the parking lot before, during, or after school is not allowed. Once you arrive at school, lock your vehicle and come into the school building. When you return to your vehicle, you should be prepared to depart the premises promptly.
8. Students are not to return to the parking lot during the school day, including lunch periods, without written permission of an administrator or an escort.
9. Students are to report any accidents, injuries, or vandalism to an administrator at the earliest opportunity. Do not move an affected vehicle until told to do so by administration or police officer.
10. Students are not permitted to ride in another student's car unless permission has been obtained from both parents and students involved. Permission slips are to be filed with the administrator in charge of parking as part of the application.
11. Students who have a registered parking permit, but drive a substitute vehicle must notify the administrator in charge of parking or his/her secretary upon arrival at school.
12. Violation of these regulations may result in: revocation of driving privilege, disciplinary action such as suspension from school, or towing of the vehicle at the owner's risk and expense.
13. WHILE ON SCHOOL PROPERTY, THE ADMINISTRATION RESERVES THE RIGHT TO SEARCH A STUDENT'S VEHICLE, IF DEEMED NECESSARY.
14. Freshmen are not allowed to drive to school.
15. Student driving privileges may be revoked at any time during the course of the year for violations of parking regulations, excessive tardiness to class/school/and or referrals.
